Wonderful news from Sue Adams and the East Surrey Family History Society Committee!

The Society has previously produced lots of useful data on fiche (remember those!) or CD format, and this has included monumental inscriptions, poor law, settlements as well as parish registers.



We will now be making this information available as a **PDF electronic download** via the online shop at GENfair www.genfair.co.uk All you will need is a computer with a PDF viewer such as Abode Reader so that the files can be read.

We have started with some of the earliest fiche such as:

- **Wimbledon Apprenticeship Indentures 1690-1895 & Poor Law Records 1698-1842**
- **Tooting Graveney Settlement Examinations 1763-1818, and**
- **Bermondsey, East Lane Chapel (Most Holy Trinity RC) baptisms 1801-1847, marriages 1808-1854 & burials 1839-1854.**

In most cases full information is provided but some are indexes which point to the full document. Many of the fiche and CDs are no longer available so this could be a new opportunity to get hold of that vital piece of information to break down your brick wall. It will be quite some time before all the data will be available as downloads so please keep checking GENfair for additions.

The downloads will be a similar or lower price than earlier formats as there is no postage and packing but **please note that GENfair has a £3 minimum order value.**
